WAMPO is seeking to fill a **Principal Engineer / Transportation Engineering, Data & Planning Manager** position depending on the candidate's qualifications. This position is responsible for managing Transportation Engineering & Data tasks pertaining to the planning process in the WAMPO region. This position is responsible for tasks related to transportation engineering, transportation modeling, transportation planning applications, transportation system performance metrics, data collection, data maintenance, data trends analysis, data presentation, and forecasting. This position is responsible for assisting in the administration of transportation-related programs and planning studies, transportation research and innovation, federal government transportation programs, data management, and grant administration. Assist in the MTP development, securing federal funding for transportation infrastructure investments (road, bridge, transit, and multimodal projects) in the WAMPO area through the development of transportation capital investment plans (TIP), long-range transportation plans, specific corridor studies, safety studies, and various other plans. This action is performed to ensure the region remains eligible to receive federal transportation funding and meets federal funding mandates.

Education and Experience Required: Minimum qualifications for the Transportation Engineering, Data & Planning Manager shall consist of a bachelor's degree in Engineering, or experience with software programming and engineering, modeling & forecasting. A minimum of 5 years of private consulting firm experience is preferred with PE (Professional Engineering) license certification.

The selected candidate must pass a background check, post-offer physical and alcohol/drug test, and have a valid driver's license.
