## PROJECTS IN THE FFY2023-FFY2026 TIP

The WAMPO FFY2023-FFY2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) includes 123 projects, with a combined cost of over \$1.5 billion. This includes:

- Projects programmed to be carried out during FFY2023-FFY2026 and projects from prior years that have been kept in the TIP because they are not yet complete (including projects some of whose phases are in FFY2022 or earlier and other of whose phases are in FFY2023 or later).

The following pages provide detailed information on each project in the FFY2023-FFY2026 TIP, including its name, location, scope, and lead agency, as well as a table showing how much money is programmed to be spent on the project, broken out by Federal Fiscal Year, project phase, and funding source.
