3. Agenda Items

A. Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP) Progress

Nicole Waldheim, Burgess & Niple, provided an overview of the CSAP progress to date and facilitated a discussion about updating the WAMPO 2021 Regional Health and Transportation Report.

Ms. Waldheim shared that her team created a transportation-safety video for WAMPO, available at https://youtu.be/4ZjuFzbLAk0.

Ms. Waldheim requested that the scheduled May 3rd SHC meeting not be canceled, so that Burgess & Niple and WAMPO may discuss and share the progress of the development of the CSAP.

The CSAP survey link was shared. It is available at https://arcg.is/0eGD8a0

A reoccurring topic discussed was the safety of pedestrians versus automobile users, and the committee wanted this topic to be delved into. They also wanted to add a dedicated safety section to the WAMPO Regional Health and Transportation Report and to look at distracted-driver reports, while focusing broadly on all things other than just pedestrians and bicycle riders (i.e., goods and services). To this end, Allison Smith, KDOT, announced the City of Wichita is updating its bicycle plan and will soon meet with a consultant to discuss how to proceed.

Adrienne Byrne, Sedgwick County, said that the Sedgwick County Health Department has data on health-related activity and safety. She said she would share it with Ms. Bryers to share with the committee. Ms. Byrne said she would also investigate distracted driving campaigns based on the discussion.

Ms. Waldheim said she would add safety and equity to the memo due to the discussion. She said the next steps are to create a memo outline with WAMPO staff and share the outline with the SHC members at the May 3rd, 2023, SHC meeting.
